

Open Call for Student Applications under Erasmus+ Programme at the Turiba University, Latvia

Duration of the Mobility:

Students will study at the Turiba University, Latvia during the second semester of the academic year 2022-2023.

Who is eligible?

MTU students who during the 2022-2023 academic year will be in the second and third year of bachelor and also students of the first and second year of master's from the followinf faculties and programs:

- Faculty of Economics (Bachelor and Master);

(Programme: Business Administration and MBA)

- Faculty of Computer Science and IT (bachelor);

(Programs: Computer Engineering)

Language of Teaching:

The language of teaching will be in English.

The scholarships include:

- Monthly compensation for students (800 EUR per month);
- Travel costs (depending on the distance between the host and home universities).

Documents required for application:

- Copy of Passport
- Certificate and Transcript of Records;
- CV
- Learning Agreement *



* Learning Agreement is a contract between the home university and the applicant and serves to determine the courses you will study at the host university. You only need to complete the first section "Before the mobility. Table A defines the subjects and credits you will receive at the host university, table B defines which of the subjects of Table A will be recognized at Tirana Metropolitan University when you have completed the exchange period.

ATTENTION: You must choose to complete at the Turiba University in Latvia the same courses that you would complete in the second semester of the academic year 2022/2023 in your faculty, so that the courses and credits will be recognized when come back If the selected subjects differ from those you would develop in your faculty, then when you return you must take the exam for the subjects are not recognised in Metropolitan Tirana University.

The "Learning Agreement" document in the "Commitment" section is signed by the applicant and then in the "sending university" section it is signed by the Head of the Department at UMT.

Application deadline: November 14th, 2022.
